Interpreting the Candidate Report

To pass the TASC Test you must achieve a minimum scale score of 500 on the Mathematics, Reading, Social Studies and Science subtests. The requirement to pass the Writing subtest is a minimum score of 500 and a minimum of 2 out of 8 on the writing essay.

Mastery Indicators provide diagnostic information that indicate areas of strength and needs in each subtest. An examinee who achieves mastery on an objective has scored as well or better on that objective than a typical examinee who scored a 500 -- the pass score -- for that subtest. An examinee who achieves low mastery on an objective should consider additional study or instructional opportunities on that objective.
